*Order and composition of divisions may change at the discretion of officials and/or tournament director.

<u>1st Place, 2nd Place and 3rd Place medals will be given for the following divisions:</u> Individual Kata, Individual Kumite, Individual Kobujutsu 3 Persons Team Kata and Team Kumite

A minimum of three (3) competitors required for a division to be held. If there are less than three competitors, one of the following may occur: Division may be combined with next higher division. U.S. Hakua Kai Karate Do reserves the right to refuse participation to any individual. Changes may be made at the discretion of tournament officials alone, or with tournament director.

<u>Kumite</u>

Beginner divisions will not receive points for face attack.

<u>Gloves, mouthpiece, chest protectors are required for females and youth under 18. Groin protectors required</u> for males. Head gear and chest protectors will be required for some divisions and will be on-hand when needed. <u>Shin guards and instep protectors are optional equipment for kumite.</u>

Coaching of the competitors is **not** allowed. Individuals who insist on coaching may be ejected from the tournament.

A tie score will go into one-minute overtime. Contestant with most points at the end of overtime period is the winner. If another tie, or no score, first person to score will win. Next over time judges will decide the winner. Penalties may be given as follows, and may be accelerated if warranted. Penalties are carried over into overtime period(s).

Black belts:

Chukoku – warning, Keikoku – one point penalty, Hansoku – disqualification (First and Second Jogai is a warning; third and fourth have a one-point penalty, fifth is disqualification).

Kata requirements:

Must perform Japanese or Okinawan kata. All kata divisions will have four corner judges plus a referee.

5.0 – 7.0 for beginner divisions, 6.0 – 8.0 for intermediate divisions, 7.0 - 9.0 for advanced divisions.

Competitors in the pee-wee, beginner and intermediate divisions are allowed to start their kata over if they forget their place or stop kata in the middle.

6 kyu and below (adult, youth, pee-wee):

Beginner divisions may only perform basic level Katas. Examples of suitable Katas: Taikyokus, Kihons, Heians (1-5), Pinans (1-5), Gekisai (Ichi or Ni), Saifa, Sanchin, Kanshiwas, Uechi-ryu style, Tioshi Shodan. Other beginner level traditional katas are ok.

5 kyu to 4 kyu (adult and junior):

Examples: Heian (1-5) or Pinan (1-5), Tekki or Naihanchi (2 or 3), Kanshu, Wankan, Jion, Aoyagi, Sanchin, Shinsein Ni, Jitte, Jiin, Saifa, Seisan, Hangetsu, etc. Fair level matching is important.

3rd kyu to 1st kyu (Adult, Youth Advanced)

Examples: Tekki or Naihanchi 3, Jion, Bassai Dai, Bassai Sho, Jiin, Empi, Chintei, Jitte, Saifa, Seisan, Koshokun Sho, Matsukaze, Sochin, etc. Fair level matching is Important.

Black belt:

Examples: Gojushijo Sho and Dai, Unsu, Kushanku, Kanku Dai and Sho, Chinto, Supar-Eimpei, Nipai-Po, Seinchin, Sochin, Chinshu, Tomari and Matsumura Bassai, Hakutsuru, Jion, Bassai Sho, Rohai Dai and San, Matsumura Rohai, Empi, Sanseiru, Chatanyara Kushanku, Gankaku, Tensho, Myojo, Sepai, Kururunfa, Chintei, Jitte, Jion, Juroku, Koshokun Dai, etc.

<u>Team Kata:</u>

Each team must have three (3) members – any mix of male and/or female.

Any formation is acceptable, but kata must begin and end in same formation.

- Beginner division teams must be comprised of persons of **no higher rank than 7 Kyu.**
- Intermediate must be comprised of person's 6 Kyu to 4 Kyu (no Brown belts).
- Advanced division comprised of 3 Kyu to 1Kyu Brown and or Black Belt. ***

No Pinan, Heian or other beginner level kata may be performed in advanced divisions.

Scoring: Beginner: 5.0 – 7.0 Intermediate: 6.0 – 8.0 Advanced: 7.0 – 9.0

TOURNAMENT RULES

Kumite (General Sparring):

- 1) All competitors must wear a mouth piece to compete. Male competitors must wear a groin cup.
- 2) Hand pads, chest protectors and other protective gear are available at the tournament. Shin pads and head gear are allowed.
- 3) Each match is **1.5 minutes or 2 minutes** in length. The time clock runs continuously unless stopped by the ring referee or official. An "**end of match**" warning will be given by the time keeper **30** seconds prior to the end of the match. ****** (Advanced and Black Belts 2 Minutes, Below Brown 1.5 Minutes) ******
- 4) For divisions below Black belt the first contestant to score **3 points** wins.
- 5) For Brown and Black belt divisions, the first contestant to score **3 points** will win.
- 6) The contestant with the highest point total after the initial time period wins the match.
- 7) In the event of a tie score there is a 1-minute overtime period. The contestant with the <u>highest point</u> <u>total</u> after the overtime period is the winner. <u>*** Starting all over from Zero Points. ***</u>
- 8) If no contestant scores or if there is a tie score after the overtime period, a **second overtime**, **1-minute overtime** begins, and the first person to score will win. After second overtime and no score, then the winner is decided by a judges' decision.
- 9) For each match, one contestant designated Blue and the other Red (will be given a red scarf to wear on their belt). Each judge has a Blue and Red flag. The color of flag raised by a judge will indicate contestant either won a point or indicates a foul. Decision will be made if a Penalty may be given.
- 10) Each ring has one referee and four judges.
- 11) Contact penalties are given for: Hitting or Kicking below the belt, contact to the head, use of excessive force, or use of uncontrolled techniques. A contestant may target the head but contact is strictly prohibited. *Black and Brown Belts may have light contact to the head*. The *first contact* penalty receives a warning from the referee. A *second contact* penalty results in the referee's warning and the opponent will be rewarded a point. A *third contact* penalty results in the contestant being disqualified and losing the match. Any deliberate contact, use of excessive force, or use of an uncontrolled technique results in the contestant being immediately disqualified.
- 12) **Jogai** (going out of the ring). Contestants are penalized for going out of the ring during the match. The first and second Jogai receive a warning from the referee. The third Jogai will result in a point being awarded to the opponent. A fourth Jogai will result in a point, and the fifth Jogai will result in disqualification.

Kata:

- 1) There are Three to Five Judges per ring. <u>With 3 Judges</u>, a contestant's score is the sum of all judge's scores. <u>With 5 judges</u>, only the three middle scores are used (high and low scores are excluded).
- 2) In the event of a tie score, the low score will be added to the contestant's scores. If still tied, the high scores will be added in. ***Any remaining tie will be resolved by number 3 below. ***
- 3) In the event a tied score still exists, contestants are required to perform another Kata. Beginner and Intermediate divisions contestants may perform the same Kata. Advance Division contestants must perform a different Kata.
